I would like to put on record my objection to the planning application outlined above.

The proposed changes do not reflect adequately the issues that have been raised regarding the traffic in the area. Today for instance there was a van parked on Hepworth lane to do some work at a house and we were unable to get past in our car. This is a regular occurrence, adding an extra up to 150 cars, not to say all the delivery trucks would be stupid, the roads are not fit for purpose now.

The traffic measures proposed, whilst including a couple of speed bumps does not take into account the actual issue which is parking and being able to get your car through at busy times such as school drop off and pick up and when there is football on gilder fields. The issue is lines of sight for driving and kids walking out behind cars, not the speed that is travelled as you have no chance to get up to speed due to the swerving in and out of parked cars.

Adding further cars to this area and delivery trucks would make it a no drive zone.

For instance the delivery trucks delivering fences when work was carried out couldn't even get in the road on Woodward court and brought the whole place to a standstill

Please reject this proposal as it is not sustainable, there is not the school places, doctors places or road infrastructure to sustain a development of this size
