Objection to 2025/93355 Extending the yellow line on the south side of Woodward Court into the new development and the proposed car park adjacent to No 7 Woodward Court will not solve school related dangerous parking activities, only add to it! Which 30 years history has shown is not policed by Kirklees Traffic Wardens, who stay in front of the school entrance and only appear 3/4 times per year. The southern road exit from the new development into Hepworth Lane will create a rat-run around the southern very narrow section of Wellhouse Ln and its very narrow junction with Flash Ln. Creating more traffic flow through the already dangerous Woodward Ct/ Wellhouse Ln junction. In addition the rat run will exit via Hepworth Ln into Shillbank Ln on very narrow blind junction. Exiting or entering this junction to the right is high risk. The proposed development created rat run will also see increased traffic flow through north Wellhouse Ln in front of the school via Jenny Ln, as an alternative to the permanently parking contested Greenside Road. With regard to the proposed substation location adjacent to 7 Woodward Court. Directly adjacent with the established private garden boundary in contradiction to the Kirklees local plan policy LP 24. What will be the route of the supply cable? If it is from the existing substation on Greenside Rd, then the route will be via Greenside Rd, Jenny Ln, Wellhouse Ln in front of the school and Woodward Ct.
