We are strongly opposed to this application.

This is the second time that we have objected to the proposed poultry shed, and it is for the same reasons that we object once more.

A poultry shed in this area would be severely unhygienic, it would cause a horrendous smell, and it would encourage vermin in a clean neighbourhood. The noise would also be unacceptable - this neighbourhood is highly regarded as a calm, peaceful area and to erect a poultry shed would be to severely damage this reputation and it would negatively impact those that live here, including ourselves.

With regards to noise and odour, we would not be able to have our windows open if a poultry shed is built. It would be unbearable noise all throughout the day and night (constant), and the smell would be constant too, and this negatively and directly impacts our quality of living and the quality of the neighbourhood. Similarly, we would not be able to enjoy time in our garden or walks in the neighbourhood (and so many travel here for the purpose of walks) due to the horrendous smell, dust, and noise. This would not be because of personal dislike but because of basic health and safety reasons. Likewise, there are many small children within the neighbourhood, with a local nursery and a local school also, and it would severely impact their health and wellbeing, including their ability to safely and comfortably play outside as it is their right to do so. The dust, smell, noise, would make it unbearable for adults and children alike. It would also be unsightly and negatively impact the generally lovely views of our neighbourhood that many live here and travel to, to enjoy. It would also negatively impact the environment, which currently is thriving with local wildlife and a variety of plants and flowers that contribute to our stunning natural landscape. A poultry shed would damage this, encouraging vermin as mentioned and flies, and the runoff would damage the grass and flowers and trees. Not to mention that it is proposed to be built in a field, which means it would damage the grass and plants there, when we should be preserving this, especially considering the current state of the environment globally and within our local community. We need to be considerate of this and protect and cultivate what we have, as opposed to damaging and ruining it, which a poultry shed would do.

In conclusion, the erection of a poultry shed would be severely detrimental to the local environment, the quality of the neighbourhood, and the quality of our lives. In short, it simply cannot be permitted.
