There looks to be plans to put a new footpath to the existing one over the green area that residents of Weavers pay for. Who will be responsible for any new path added, our management team will not take it on. I will have houses overlooking my windows and property lines will go to my boundary. My house is on a slope. What precautions will the builders take to not affect my foundations. How will site traffic be managed, Our estate is not suitable for parking on - there are no residential parking spaces here. I work from home during the day and my office is at the back of my property, What measures will there be to keep noise at a minimum and all site traffic incl employees and deliveries on site (and have a planning condition to prevent them parking on our estate) and will there be wheel washing facilities, Thorpe Green Lane has just been patched by the council due to the wear and tear of building traffic using this route, Can the road be resurfaced if the patches wear unduly due to the site traffic, There is a problem with sewage, the pipe runs across the green and my pipes have blocked 4 x. The last time the report said the pipe wasn't sloped enough. Adding more waste pipes would add to the issues, Our path across the green can't be used in winter due to the weather, adding pedestrians to this route will likely result in the path wearing more quickly and residents being expected to meet these costs.
