<p>I wish to object to the application for planning permission.</p> <p>The 28 houses would fill in the patch of green that currently exists. The landscape in the area is made up of buildings interspersed with green areas and this development will alter irrevocably the patchwork as described.</p> <p>The area of Longwood has no school and a very limited bus service (one bus per hour at best). This is not the place for more housing.</p> <p>Any development will cause an increase in traffic and the surrounding roads are often narrow or not designed for the volume of traffic (particularly Dodlee Lane). Further development will add to the existing congestion and noise. During any construction there will be heavy vehicles which the roads cannot sustain.</p> <p>There is wildlife in the area, including rabbits and foxes, and their habitat will be eroded by the proposed development. Wildlife have already lost habitat through the development that abuts the one proposed and there could be environmental repercussions with additional building.</p> <p>As the proposed site is sloped it will not be subject to flooding. However, the water will run down from there and eventually into Milnsbridge which is much more likely to flood. Grassland is required to absorb surplus water and I request that this is further considered and that the application is declined.</p> <p>I have read that pipes have been blocked in the area and that sewage has been washed into the river. I did not see any reference in the application form about improving sewerage. Please give this matter full consideration</p>
