<p>I would like to raise concerns about the traffic conditions on Thorpe Green Drive. This lane used to be quite cul de sac, however after already building 90+ houses Thorpe Green has now become a busy road. The section that sweeps around onto Weavers lane is especially dangerous and visibility is very poor. Vehicles frequently cut the corner due to the tight geometry and lack of sightlines due to hedges, creating a genuine safety hazard for both drivers and pedestrians. Any increase in traffic would only worsen an already dangerous situation.</p> <p>I would like to note that the estate was originally served by an access point at the end of Grange Road. However, bollards were later installed, restricting this route so that it now only serves Weavers Grove. As a result, all traffic for Weavers Lane is forced through the constrained Thorpe Green Drive. If the Grange Road access were reopened to serve the whole estate—as it previously did—traffic could be more evenly distributed, reducing pressure on the Thorpe Green Drive/Weavers Lane corner and improving overall safety.</p>
