I welcome the news that the site is going to be built on at last. I am pleased that the site will be used for much needed housing, and that there will be some affordable homes. I am also pleased that the developer will be Steve Byram who has a good record of building quality housing which fits into the Colne Valley vernacular style. I have some concerns about the amount of car parking in the plan. There are already problems on Clough Road with vans and other large vehicles parked on what is a very busy and quite dangerous road. This could be considerably improved if Clough Road had double yellow lines all the way down to Crimble Bank. There is provision for some parking at the north end of the site, but there does not seem to be any access to it (except by steps), which would present problems for mobility impaired residents. I also have concerns about the sight lines for drivers exiting this north-end car park onto Clough Road. I would like to see elevation drawings for the site as a whole.
