While I am generally supportive of the development, I was extremely disappointed by the actions of the applicant when under-taking large scale land clearance in March/April 25. Despite the clear guidance present in the surveys associated with the previous application, the applicant took no heed whatsoever of any of it. Huge quantities of earth/rocks/made ground were picked up and 'sieved' using the 2 diggers onsite, from morning until late afternoon. This created huge amounts of dust and debris. Stone sieved out was systematically dumped onto the back of a flat bed truck and driven up to be dumped in a field off Moor Side Lane. No actions were taken to do any damping, wheel washing or other safety measures to reduce fugitive dust/contamination given the guidance on the presence of elevated levels of PAH, asbestos, arsenic & lead. These activities routinely commenced without notice at around 07.15 every morning, including on Saturdays, and were incredibly noisy and disruptive. No H&S or welfare provision was in place - unfortunately on 13.03 I witnessed a driver get out of a digger and relieve himself in the middle of the site in full view of overlooking properties As I said, I am generally supportive of the development, however I do want reassurance that the applicant will now adhere to the rules, laws and restrictions associated with any approvals, and show more respect/concern for the well being of local residents, employees and future residents
