I object to this application on the following grounds: 1) the proposed buildings are only 15 metres from ancient woodland and are likely to cause damage to this important heritage site. WYCA are bringing in a 50 metre limit in March and this will be in line with Woodland Trust advice. 2) the proposed 123 houses increase the number of properties in the village by 30%, creating an intolerable strain on drainage and sewerage systems which are already unfit for purpose and constantly being repaired. 3) the field is greenbelt and should be preserved as such. The West Yorkshire Mayor has publically stated that brownfield sites should be developed before any greenbelt development. 4) the increase in traffic would cause additional congestion, increase the likelihood of accidents and increase the risk to pedestrians.
