<p>The proposed development will increase the size of the village by a third. Our roads and amenities are already at full stretch with dangerous accident hotspots. An uptick of people on a scale like this taking to their cars will make the roads & amenities unbearable in addition to the recently passed Quarry traffic at Bromley Farm.</p> <p>The taking out of a fertile Greenbelt field is utterly reprehensible when other options remain to deliver our housing quotas. Brown field sites, better management of housing stock and a finalised local plan should be addressed before even remotely looking at productive Greenbelt and allowing developers a free for all trying to get permissions before the local plan is actually finalised.</p> <p>By taking this Greenbelt for building our wonderful ecology and ancient woodland will be damaged beyond repair.</p> <p>We already have major water issues in the village. This will be exacerbated by the addition of a further 123 houses. This will undoubtedly further damage our biodiversity and create dangerous flooding in the fields and woodland surrounding the proposed site. Only this weekend 7/8 Feb the flooding to the south of this proposed building plot has been truly horrendous. It really is hard to imagine where the water will go and the damage it will do to our wildlife and trees.</p> <p>Our beautiful long range views from the church over to Birdsedge will be lost forever if this development is allowed to go ahead.</p> <p>As a local authority and nation we should be trying harder? Greenbelt is the very bedrock of our green and pleasant land. We have to try harder and be more thorough and creative and seek the best sustainable solution for our villagers and wider population.</p> <p>Please do not allow this inappropriate, ill conceived development to go ahead.</p>
