<p>I would like to object to the proposed development of 123 houses as it represents a level of development that is out of keeping with the size, character, and rural nature of the village.</p> <p>The scale and density of the proposal would result in overdevelopment, altering the character of the village and removing its identity as a small village. Such a large development would visually destroy the surrounding area and negatively impact the landscape and irreplaceable habitat.</p> <p>The proposal would place significant strain on existing infrastructure, including local roads, parking and schools. As someone who sets off to work I pass the school at 845am cars are always double parked and the local estate opposite is gridlocked making it very tricky to drive through. As we know most people nowadays do not walk there children to school so even though the new development will only be across the road we know that a high percentage will still use there car to drop off adding more traffic to the existing busy over subscribed roads. Alongside this is the quarry that has been recently been passed meaning even more traffic in the vicinity. I moved into this village so my children could attend a small primary school this now has already trebled in numbers and been extended to its maximum potential .</p> <p>For these reasons, I believe the proposal is unsustainable.A rural development on greenbelt land is not something we need when there are plenty of brownfield sites that can be used.
