<p>The site is designated green belt land and only last year was harvested for crops and is not part of the local plan.</p> <p>The site is next to ancient woodland and would end up damaging flora and fauna to which locals enjoy in peace. The roads at present can not cope with current traffic never mind an increase of up to another 160 vehicles. Especially opposite the tip and proposed Bromley development.</p> <p>The current infrastructure of water and sewage is already above its capacity with no effort by the said authorities to better in the future.</p> <p>Doctors, schools and dentists are already full in this area without the introduction of over 280 more persons. Locals enjoy the current character and views of the local landscape and does not need the introduction of unnecessary housing on green belt land, never mind the disturbance of plant machinery and noise during construction.</p> <p>Existing sites by this developer are nowhere near completion and are a blot on the landscapes.</p> <p>There are plenty of brown field sites in Kirklees ripe for development before we start allocating green field, farmland sites that are still being farmed. We cannot set a precedence to let farmers sell green belt arable land every time a developer thinks they can make a profit at the expense of locals. I strongly object to this development.</p>
