I wish to make an anonymous objection to planning application 2025/60/93572/E.

This proposed development is on protected Green Belt land outside the Local Plan.

Local GP surgeries and dentists are already over stretched, adding another 300+ people into the local community, on top of other significant local housing developments (Denby Dale, Skelmanthorpe, Shelley etc) will make local health amenities unsustainable.

Local road conditions are at best under pressure, add 200 more local cars to the fleet of HGV's which the new quarry will spawn and you have a sure fire recipe for more accidents and pedestrian casualties.

I have lived and brought up my children in Upper Cumberworth. The ancient woodlands, that will be significantly adversely impacted if this development proceeds, have been our safe natural haven away where the children have been able to learn about and enjoy nature. These ancient woodlands are irreplaceable and must be protected from the encroachment of mass housing. The preservation of the existing Green Belt is the only acceptable buffer zone to ensure that this protection is sustainable and the ancient woodlands are there for future generations.
