<p>I have lived in Upper Cumberworth all my life and feel proud and privileged to do so. I do not however, feel that the open space and greenbelt is mine to do with whatever I want. Just like my garden, I cannot just build on it because it is mine or my family own it. I therefore do not understand at all why you are considering building on greenbelt which is currently farmed and has significant environmental importance to the woodland.</p> <p>The walk down Park Lane to Stephen Wood is very well used, by dog walkers and ramblers. I also used to attend Cumberworth First School, and we used the field and woodland for walks, projects and learning, and I know it is still used for all that because only yesterday about 30 children were out walking.</p> <p>We have so many types of bird but in particular we have geese that land in the field when they are on their migration journey. We have many photographs to back up this claim.</p> <p>Things I don't like about living here which will most definitely impact on others is the lack of amenities. We have one tiny shop and everywhere is a car journey, but this will mean that the increase in traffic will mean the roads are far too busy. Lots of people already cut through Upper Cumberworth up Carr Hil Road, which then causes another long queue of traffic on a road without pavements.</p> <p>I go to Greenhead College; I get the train. I can't walk to the station as the only train to get me there is at 7.24am and with a twenty min walk on an already busy road, in the dark, where sometimes the pavement is dangerously close to the traffic, is too unsafe. In distance it might not look too bad but in reality, it's not ideal. Also, the train that is on that line is often too full, I have to always pre book just to get on it, they only have a two carriage train.</p> <p>I desperately hope you do not allow this development to go ahead.</p>
