Reasons for objection:

- The planned quarry in the same area is already going to drastically increase traffic towards a dangerous junction at the Sovereign. Adding more to that is ridiculous. Alternatively, more traffic will use Carr Hill Road - this is not fair on the residents and will cause accidents.
- The local area already cannot cope with basic amenities. Water issues regularly happen in Upper and Lower Cumberworth already. More homes will add to the issue.
- Roads are in a shocking state already in the area, more traffic will add to the issues further
- The plot is greenbelt land. Developments should be focussed on redeveloping brownbelt land.
- The development will ruin the countryside views of the area. This is a reason for living in the village. If we wanted to live in a town or city, we would move to a town or city.
- The development will destroy ancient woodland and habitats. This cannot be replaced once it is gone. There is no good reason for doing this.
- The proposal is made before the local plan review. They are undermining the process.
- There are already an unreasonable amount of unfinished projects in the HD8 area. Some of which are Vivly projects. They should be made to complete their other work first. I do not believe Vivly will be able to complete this project and so any plans submitted will not be reflected in the finished development
- Shelley College recently had to take in many pupils from outside the catchment area. Adding more homes will not be sustainable for the schools.
