<p>I have been visiting my niece and her family in Upper Cumberworth for over 25 years .The surrounding land is greenbelt land and should be protected from development as it would dwarf the village by increasing the housing by nearly a third .The development would not be in keeping with village life .The land has , as long as i have been visiting, been used to grow crops and throughout the year is home to wildlife .It would be a terrible shame to obliterate the view of the ancient woods .The existing hedgerows are not only home to wildlife but the brambles provide foraging opportunities for the villagers too .Barnsley road and Carr Hill road are also very busy roads with both junctions at the end of these roads being dangerous so I can imagine that a proposed site of 123 houses would result in at least a further 246 cars in the village which as well as the resultant noise this will also negatively affect the quality of air for the residents and the ancient woodland .I cannot see any justification for this development .</p>
