<p>My great niece and nephews live in Upper Cumberworth and I have visited them regularly .The view of the ancient woodland would be obscured from Park lane and the opposite side of the village . The conservation part of the village can ,at the moment ,be seen from Birds Edge and this view will be obliterated by this development .The land is greenbelt and has always been used for growing crops and this would be the loss of another field used for food production .This greenbelt land is not in the local plan .There is a lot of wildlife that relies on this field and the surrounding hedgerows for their food source .It is always a joy to see deer and fawns in this field and I would be sorry if this land was built upon .The development would dwarf the village which does not have the infrastructure to support a development of this size. The village is mainly accessed by car . The bus route is poorly serviced and the train is unreliable as well as being over a mile away from the proposed development .The train station has very little parking for commuters and occupants of the development are very unlikely to walk the dark lonely route to the station .This will increase the number of cars in the village and the number of additional journeys being made which in turn affects the air quality in the village . It would be completely against the National Planning Policy Framework to allow this development to proceed .</p>
