<p>I have lived in Carr Hill Road, Upper Cumberworth for 46 years and wish to put on record my strong objection to any development on this site.</p> <p>The site is Green Belt. Building here would block the beautiful view up to Birds Edge and spoil the rural setting. I am particularly concerned for the adjacent woodland and its biodiversity. I and the two of my adult children who live locally frequently walk there, as does our other child when he visits.</p> <p>The development will inevitably bring more cars to the village. With the increased traffic caused by the opening of the quarry, traffic on the main road and on nearby roads is bound to rise significantly. The Sovereign junction with the A629 and the junction at the top of Carr Hill Road are already very busy, and there have been accidents in both places. Most of Carr Hill Road has no pavements. In Denby Dale parking is already a nightmare. Bus services in the village are limited.</p> <p>I am also concerned about drainage and water supply. Building over green fields will increase run-off and damage. This is even more worrying now that the effects of climate change are obvious.</p> <p>The development will put pressure on local services, including on our already over-stretched GP practices. More school places will be needed, both primary and secondary, with a further implied cost.</p> <p>In short, the application should be turned down.</p>
