<p>I visit a friend in Upper Cumberworth regularly and she lives adjacent to the proposed site .This proposal will impact the whole of the village due to its size and detrimental effect on the neighbouring properties .There will be noise and dirt during the build and the long lasting loss of views of the conservation part of the village ie the church spire. There will be added noise from the dwellings and occupants and any animals. The village is small and very rural - this development would change the village for the worse .This land has been agricultural land and is greenbelt land .The land is not included within the local plan .There is ancient woodland adjacent to this site which is home to deer and many other creatures and fauna .The ecology of the woods is finely balanced and and a further 246 people tramping through the woods would affect it negatively .It would also be extremely sad if the hedgerows were removed or damaged during the build process .This green field and its protected Sycamore tree is the first part of Upper Cumberworth to greet visitors as they approach from Denby Dale and it serves as a separation of the two villages . This development must not proceed otherwise it sends a signal to developers that all greenbelt is fair game.</p>
