Re: Upper Cumberworth 2025/60/93572/E

I wish to object to the above planning application on the following grounds:-

1. The site is in the Green Belt and under the current Local Development Plan Policy, should not be considered for development.
2. Increased traffic on Barnsley Road. The proposed development would greatly increase the number of cars and delivery vans in the village. This, together with the additional

120 HGV movements per day at the Bromley Farm Quarry site, will significantly affect an already fast and busy road.

3. Any development would increase the demand on the water supply and any building on open land will increase the likelihood of excessive run off & flooding during prolonged wet winters.
4. The UK is increasingly dependant on imported food; we are currently at 62% self sufficiency and it is falling rapidly. We should not, therefore, consider any development on agricultural land.
5. Green space and woodlands are precious; it is our heritage and our responsibility to keep it safe for future generations. Once built on, it is lost for ever.

For all the above reasons, I urge you to reject this application.
