<p>My husband and I visit our relatives in Upper Cumberworth on a regular basis, and we love the village. The plans to build on that land with the beautiful sycamore tree in the middle is outrageous. I cannot see how they can get 123 houses onto that field. It will be unnaturally overloaded. And the cars it will add to the village's roads is asking for trouble. There are already serious accident blackspots at the Sovereign garage and at the top of Carr Hill Road. It beggar's belief that someone would even suggest such a dense and out of character development, and shows the architect and builders have no understanding about the village and the fabric of the place. Such a big estate in such a small village would be incongruous with the rolling hills and countryside feel of the area. On top of this, it will lead to accidents and possibly fatalities by packing hundreds of more cars onto those village roads and into the traffic blackspot at the Sovereign crossroads. Councillors could have blood on their hands if the safety warnings are not heeded and more vehicle usage leads to more crashes. All villages need to grow and develop, but let this peaceful place evolve and develop slowly so it keeps its character rather than exploding with this outrageous estate and driving a wedge in the community.</p>
