<p>I wish to object to the development of 123 houses that are proposed to be built on Greenbelt land in our village.</p> <p>The issues of road safety for pedestrians and vehicles, the sewage and water situations and the difficulty of getting Doctor's appointments in this area are all of great concern; not to mention the damage to the woodland and yet another field discarded when we need land that produces food.</p> <p>All these issues will only be made worse by the development of these houses.</p> <p>The main road through the village is extremely busy with many vehicles ignoring the speed limit and it leads to a junction at the Sovereign which is known for its many accidents. The road itself is not in good repair and with more lorries from the Quarry development already going to be added to the number, the situation will not improve.</p> <p>Many people already bring their children to the school in the car and the congestion on Cumberworth Lane and by our one shop and post office often makes the road dangerous for those on foot and in their cars.</p> <p>I believe some people have issues with water pressure already and certainly we know that the manhole covers in Barnsley Road often 'blow off' causing danger to the road users whenever there is any heavy rain. This is therefore going to be even worse when the field is no longer there to absorb the rain water along with the increased waste water and sewage from the new houses.</p> <p>I think with the development that has already been allowed in the surrounding villages the safety of people and the infrastructure of this area is once again being ignored and this development should be refused.</p>
