<p>I have been a resident in Upper Cumberworth for 37 years and wish to object to the proposed development of 123 houses in the village on land that is currently Greenbelt and used for farming.</p> <p>I am concerned for the following reasons:</p> <p>The sewage and water problems in the village are going to be made worse with the increased population. The sewage manhole cover on Barnsley Road near to the proposed development entrance gets 'lifted' in heavy rain which is a danger. The field must act as a soak away and once this is all built upon it will cause an increase in the amount of water entering the already inadequate drainage system.</p> <p>The increase in traffic will make already dangerous and congested roads worse, particularly around the school and village shop/post office which are already difficult areas.</p> <p>There will be a negative environmental impact on the wild life that inhabit the field and the wood that runs along side it.</p> <p>This development would add a significant number of people using the already 'stretched' Doctor's services.</p> <p>I feel that this proposed development is not a positive move for those residents already here or those who would move into the area.</p>
