

I would like to list my objections to the proposed 123 houses in Upper Cumberworth for the following reasons

The site will destroy designated GREEN BELT land which is productive farm land, which encourages a wide variety of wildlife Deer, Geese, Rabbits and Hares which would all suffer.

The nearby woodland with TPO's would also be affected, by alteration to drainage and also increased top water carrying detergents and residues off all the cons.

Barnsley Road is only just adequate for the existing traffic, so a substantial increase would create more problems.

The road only has 1 pavement which is not very wide for pedestrians and the 40 mph limit is very rarely adhered to, and both the STAR and Sovereign CROSSROADS are accident black spots already

I am a resident of [redacted] and we already have issues with blocked drains which do not take water the all length of the road. Our neighbours had a damaged sewer pipe which took over 18 months to get fully repaired. So I am sure the increase in sewerage will be a bigger problem

The site will certainly alter the character

of our village beyond repairs and harm  
our heritage assets and the historical  
remains of a old mill in the woods

I really do hope you consider my  
concerns seriously as it will affect  
everyone in the village.
