Any additional traffic would be very concerning as each proposed new property will have at least one vehicle and this will only add to the imminent HGV traffic Quarry traffic which will shortly be using the village roads. Another problem on this road is the number of water main bursts which have occurred this past year at a point just higher from where the exit of the site is proposed.
