As a long time resident of Upper Cumberworth, having raised my family here, I would like to express objection to the proposed housing development referenced above.

I am not opposed in principle to the construction of housing, however I strongly believe the proposed development to be totally inappropriate. The site is in close proximity to ancient woodland and natural watercourses. The would-be developers have not taken into account factors such as the slope of the site, nor insufficient provision for sewerage. These could be highly detrimental to both aquatic and terrestrial wildlife, and also cause flooding downstream.

Over many years local voluntary groups have to their great credit improved conditions for biodiversity and environmental benefit. Local residents, myself included, are proud of what has been achieved, and would certainly not wish to see it negated.

In addition, the main A635, already busy with traffic using the recycling facility at Bromley Farm, would be further impacted by access from this site.
