<p>As a person that walks this village, its paths & its pavements everyday I am shocked firstly by the plan to build on greenbelt and next to our ancient woodland, but also by the sheer inaccuracies in the "professional" reports submitted. A plan submitted outside the local plan, not to scale, with blatantly incorrect distances quoted from the development to commerce, train station, fuel station and public transport availability and figures for car movement based on an average that isn't relevant in a village in the countryside with higher than average car ownership. An ecology report that fails to mention wildlife. I object strongly to developers behaving in this manner.</p> <p>120 houses will add upwards of 300 cars (600+ movements) to one of the most dangerous bits of road in KMC. My grandchildren walk on these uneven surfaces and are already terrified by the traffic.</p> <p>We walk in the woods most days, seeing all sorts of wildlife and the ancient remains..they want to build to 10m, totally against national standards of 50m. This endangers our heritage and our green space. The run off from the site will be a toxic mix and will get into the ecosystem of our woods.</p> <p>The stunning view from the top of Park Lane across to the church spire will be lost forever. Passing this will destroy a beautiful village. There is no need for these houses, there are hundreds for sale in the area and thousands of empty houses and plenty of places that need regenerating.
