<p>I object because:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The current view is beautiful and it would be a tragedy to lose it. The field, with the trees, is an essential part of the character of our village. I feel strongly that we need to protect 'our green and pleasant land'. We mustn't let our green spaces, the beautiful British countryside disappear – we should protect it for future generations to enjoy. This land is greenbelt – that means it should be valued and protected. Nature is a resource for us all – even just looking at green spaces improves mental health. I feel strongly that new houses, if they are needed, should be built on existing brownfield sites.2. I'm very worried about the potential impact on the ancient woodland which is next to the field. This is such a precious, beautiful place and essential if we want to protect and develop biodiversity. Over the past year we've seen many types of woodland birds in there including woodpeckers, owls and buzzards. We've also seen deer (they were also in the field itself).3. The woodland also is home to archeological remains – more which may be in the field itself.4. This planning proposal is outside of the Kirklees Local Plan.5. The road is already dangerous and more cars will make it more dangerous.6. There has been an ongoing problem of a water leak on the road. What will be the impact on the local water supply if all these new houses are built?7. Barnsley Road does not have footpaths which are safe for children / families / elderly to walk along.
