<p>Planning Application 2025/193572</p> <p>I wish to object to the above planning application on the grounds of its size and its location.</p> <p>To consider building at all on designated Green Belt land is surely sufficient to refuse the the applicatio coupled with its proximity to ancient woodland with its varied wildlife. These woods are the home of Deer, and Foxes while in the adjacent field can be found Hare which are almost invisible until you almost tread on them (I write from personel experience on this matter.)</p> <p>To build this many houses on this site would totaly change the special character of the village and would contribute to the urban sprawl already experienced in Denby Dale, Shepley, Shelley and Clayton West, the very thing that the introduction of the Green Belt was designed to prevent. The "special circumstances" which allows building on such land would surely not apply in this instance.</p> <p>The proposed site is poorly served by what can only decribed as roads on which accidents are waiting to happen. Barnsley Road is already extremely busy at peak times and in attempting to avoid the log-jam at the Sovereign Junction, minor roads such as Carr Hill Road become little more than a car park at the junction with Penistone Road. This road was never designed to take these volumes of traffic with its lack of footpaths and is already the choice of route of pedestrians, dog walkers, joggers and cyclists enjoying the surrounding countryside.</p> <p>For these reasons I repectfully request that planning permission be refused.</p>
