<p>I wish to object to this application as a regular walker in the area. This site is adjacent to the ancient woodland that forms part of the Upper Dearne way and is published in a number of walking manuals . It is important because of its heritage and association with ancient mill routes for workers. The long range vista from Birdsedge is one to celebrate as you look across to the Church of St Nicholas , present on that site since the 12th century. I do not accept the assertion in the LVIA that the impact is minimal and that the housing in Dearnfield and Hollybank already impact this sight line so it doesn't matter. It matters very much especially given the size and scope of what is proposed .</p> <p>I'm also concerned regarding traffic , it is already almost impossible to cross Barnsley Road and that will be added to with the start of the quarry campaign . The transport figures are nonsense, inaccurate in terms of access and egress from the site and in terms of distance from Denby Dale. We know people will not walk , they will drive - just visit cumberworth lane on a school day to see this. It's impossible to turn into this road some days with the volume of school traffic . It's an accident waiting to happen .</p> <p>Do the correct thing and refuse this application .</p>
