<p>I am writing to formally object to the proposed planning application for development on the greenfield site located on the main road near our community.</p> <p>First and foremost, the loss of this greenfield land would have a significant and irreversible impact on the local environment. The site currently provides valuable natural space that supports local wildlife and biodiversity. Development would inevitably disturb or displace animals and reduce the ecological value of the area.</p> <p>The proposal also raises serious concerns regarding traffic and road safety. The site sits on a busy main road, and additional vehicle movements generated by the development would likely increase congestion and create potential hazards for residents, pedestrians, and other road users. This is particularly concerning given the presence of elderly residents in nearby homes who may be more vulnerable to traffic-related risks.</p> <p>Noise and disruption during both the construction phase and ongoing use of the development would negatively affect neighbouring properties. Residents currently benefit from a relatively quiet environment, and the introduction of heavy machinery, construction traffic, and increased day-to-day activity would significantly reduce the quality of life for those living nearby.</p> <p>Furthermore, the development would place additional pressure on local infrastructure and services while removing a natural green space that contributes to the character and wellbeing of the community.</p> <p>For these reasons, including the loss of greenfield land, potential harm to wildlife, increased traffic and safety concerns, noise disturbance, and the impact on nearby residents, I strongly urge the planning authority to refuse this application.</p>
