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I would like to raise the strongest objection to the above planning application in Upper Cumberworth.

I do not believe the local area will benefit in any way from this development. This is clear from the amount of objections raised and the negative feeling of existing residents.

I believe the plans will have an adverse effect on our amenity services, we already experience a greatly above average number of power cuts and 100+ additional houses will further increase the strain on this network. Additional strain on water services, both drains and supply again will be an issue.

The ancient woodland, in my opinion isn't being given the respect and protection it deserves. Im sure the developer is not interested in this or any other countryside or wildlife protection, just profit. If it wasn't about profit they would and should be looking at brown field sites not greenbelt which should be strongly protected by Kirklees council.

What provision if approved will the council make to amenities in the area. Will there be additional school places at the local primary?

How will the local doctors and dentist surgeries cope with several hundred more patients?

The traffic in this area is already dreadful. I cannot imagine what it will be like if this development gets approval. I live on Carr Hill road, already an overused rat run with a speed limit that is rarely observed. There is a 'supposed' 3ton limit on vehicles downhill that is ignored and never policed.

With no footpaths fir most of its length I already have had several near missed will walking at the road side. How will this development improve any of this? It wont.

This development will be detrimental to the whole area and is not required or wanted.
