<p>I wish to formally object to the planning application of a new housing estate in Upper Cumberworth. This land has always been greenbelt land and it concerns me greatly that if this application is accepted that there will be no limit on the number of applications for house building on greenbelt land. Land was designated as greenbelt to prevent urban sprawl and protect the green spaces. No matter on the governments or councils requirement to build a certain number of new houses, greenbelt land has always been and should always be protected and remain green space. There are also serious concerns on the wildlife and habitats that will be moved/ destroyed with this build particularly with it being so close to ancient woodlands.
