<p>I object to this development as it is too close to the woodland. There is nowhere near a large enough buffer zone. It is too close to trees and the boundary of the woodland. It will ruin the natural environment of the woodland. Houses should not be built close to the trees and the woods.</p> <p>The river and the habitat of animals in the wood will be negatively impacted by the proposed development forever. The woodland will never be the same. A development of this size is too big and will cause devastating impact on the woodland and its habit.</p> <p>It is Greenbelt land and should stay as Greenbelt land.</p> <p>This planning application has many inaccuracies in the reports which have been submitted with the application.</p> <p>The road safety analysis included in the application has been done at quiet times of day and avoided peak times. It has not considered the dangerous junction at the sovereign which is close to the proposed development and will be even more dangerous with hundreds more cars using the roads nearby. The main road will end up being full of parked cars as there is not enough space for parking in the plans as many households have two or more cars.</p> <p>The proposed development is out of character of the local area, adding significantly more properties than the village has. It will negatively impact on the whole village. A proposal of a much smaller scale would fit better with the local character. For example a row of houses along the main road. Leaving the rest of the fields as green belt agricultural land.</p> <p>The information about the residents consultation in this application was inaccurate.
