I wish to submit an addendum to my previous full objection of 19/02/26 (Your ref: 1128073 published 25/02/2026)

In addition to the points made then regarding infrastructure, I would like to raise the issue of ground water run off and potential pollution as a result. Potentially, oil and rubber residues etc from vehicles, amongst other things could end up in the woods, Park Dike and the upper River Dearne. Ground water and sewerage provision are dealt with comprehensively in the objection by Yorkshire Water, but the impact on local watercourses should concern everyone.

Secondly, another wildlife/environmental concern relating to the concreting over of natural grassland/arable land is the loss of insect life and knock on effects on bird life. Anyone who saw the "Secret Garden" with David Attenborough last week would know just how the populations of birds such as swallows have declined over recent years, with loss of insects as their food a significant factor. The facts are horrifying and proposals like this just pile on the harm.
