Families, elderly residents, and vulnerable individuals rely on this space. Taking it away shows a lack of regard for the real needs of the community. Furthermore, this development will directly block my view and reduce natural light to my property, creating a more cramped, oppressive, and unpleasant living environment. I did not choose to live here to have my outlook and quality of life sacrificed for inappropriate development. It is extremely disappointing that this application appears to prioritise short-term financial gain over long-term community wellbeing, environmental protection, and responsible planning. This proposal fails to respect existing residents and the character of the area. I strongly urge Kirklees Council to reject this application and fulfil its duty to protect local communities and green spaces. Residents deserve better than this.
