I am writing to express my strongest, most serious, and absolute objection to planning application 2026/60/90116/E, currently under consideration by Kirklees Council. I am furious that this proposal has been allowed to progress at all. It demonstrates a complete and unacceptable disregard for local residents, our wellbeing, and our environment. The destruction of this green space is indefensible. This is not land “waiting to be developed” — it is a vital lifeline for this community. Destroying it for profit-driven overdevelopment is shameful. At a time when mental health is at crisis levels, it is beyond belief that the Council would consider removing one of the few remaining places where people can escape stress, noise, and overcrowding. Families, elderly residents, and vulnerable individuals depend on this space. Ignoring this reality is reckless and irresponsible. This development will block my view, reduce natural light, and fundamentally damage my living environment. My home will become darker, more enclosed, and far less pleasant to live in. I did not invest in my property to have my quality of life deliberately undermined. This application places money and developer interests above people, community, and common sense. It represents short-sighted planning that will permanently damage the character of this area. Residents’ voices are being sidelined and ignored, which is deeply frustrating and unacceptable. Kirklees Council has a clear duty to protect its communities, not sacrifice them. I expect this harmful and inappropriate proposal to be firmly rejected.
