I am writing to register my absolute strongest and most furious objection to planning application 2026/60/90116/E, currently under consideration by Kirklees Council. I am genuinely outraged that this proposal has progressed to this stage. It represents a complete abandonment of responsibility to local residents and a shocking disregard for community wellbeing, environmental protection, and basic common sense. The permanent destruction of this green space is reckless, unjustifiable, and deeply irresponsible. This land is not surplus, disposable, or “available” — it is essential to the daily lives and mental health of the people who live here. At a time when mental health is in crisis and access to outdoor space is more important than ever, it is disgraceful that the Council is even entertaining a proposal that would remove one of the few remaining places where residents can find peace, relief from stress, and a sense of balance. Families, elderly residents, and vulnerable individuals depend on this space. To ignore this is negligent. This development will block my view, reduce daylight, and fundamentally damage my home environment. My property will become darker, more enclosed, and significantly less liveable. I did not invest my time, money, and future in my home only to have my quality of life stripped away for short-term development. This application prioritises developer profit over people, concrete over community, and short-term gain over long-term responsibility. It reflects planning at its worst — dismissive, short-sighted, and harmful. Residents are being ignored and treated as obstacles rather than stakeholders. Kirklees Council exists to serve its communities, not sacrifice them. I expect this damaging and unacceptable proposal to be rejected in full. Anything less would represent a serious failure of duty and trust.
