Good afternoon,

I hope you are all well.

I can confirm that your attached drawings are now technically approved for construction.

Please can you provide me with the Programme of Works ASAP, so that the street lighting works can be coordinated by our Street Lighting Team. (Note: Payment of the street lighting invoice hasn't shown up on our system at present, however it can take a few days to process – I will reach out if there are any issues). I also require the target date of completion for the works, so that I can begin to organise the adoption of land using a S228.

That being said, I am aware that there have been some discussions regarding a Vehicular Dropped Crossing alternative (as opposed to a bell mouth). Please note that if you wish to proceed in this way, any drawings will have to be re-approved by Planning and Highway Development Control, and then technically approved again by me.

NEXT STEPS:

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Your contractor will now need to make the necessary S184 application before he can carry out any works on the Public Highway.

The application for the S184 can be made via:-

Please be aware that once the S184 has been approved you may not undertake any work to existing highways until you have co-ordinated the works (to book the 'road space') with, and had approval for any Traffic Management requirements from, our Street Works Team.

To contact the Street Works team please email tma.permits@kirklees.gov.uk with the following information:-

- Location and extent of work
- A copy of the approval to carry out the work
- Anticipated start date
- Anticipated duration
- Details of proposed Traffic Management

Works should not commence until you have received confirmation in writing (usually via email) from the Street Works Team that you are OK to proceed.

You can check to see to see other current and planned works at the location of the proposed works at: <https://www.one.network/>. This will help with your planning, to check whether 'road space' is likely to be available for when you are wanting to work.
