If the goal of this redevelopment is truly to improve Marsden for the people who live here, then the developers need to consider our smallest residents—the children we all have a duty to protect.</p> <p>Right now, the walk to school is a struggle. kids walking to Marsden Infants, Marsden Juniors, and the park have to go down narrow, single-lane roads with absolutely no pavements. Children should feel completely safe walking to school, and they deserve proper, safe pathways to get there. A permanent footbridge across the river directly to the school is absolutely paramount.</p> <p>Additionally, the proposed car park is a major issue. Putting it so close to the schools and the village centre will create a toxic mix of gridlock, idling cars, and pollution right where children walk every day.
