<p>As a lifelong Marsden resident, I write in unequivocal support of the proposed works. I strongly urge the committee to approve this application without further delay.</p> <p>The derelict mill occupies a significant portion of the village and has, for far too long, remained an unacceptable blight on the local landscape. It is not only an eyesore that detracts from the character and appeal of Marsden but also presents an ongoing and very real health and safety concern.</p> <p>The prospect of maintaining the status quo for another 20 years is, in my view, entirely unacceptable. Doing nothing is not a viable option. Progress on this site is long overdue, and these proposals represent a positive and much-needed step forward for the village.</p> <p>Concerns regarding access and safety for children attending the infants' school appear to be addressed by the plans, particularly with the removal of the former "wages" office, which would create a wider and safer pedestrian route.</p> <p>This development has the potential to bring clear and lasting benefits to Marsden, both visually and practically. I would therefore respectfully but firmly ask the committee to avoid any further unnecessary delays. The time for indecision has passed—this project needs to move forward with urgency before the site deteriorates further.</p>
