Description

- Change of use of the existing industrial storage unit to a wholesale supermarket.
- Erection of a single-storey extension measuring approximately 15,000mm x 20,000mm, positioned to the southern end of the building, as shown on the submitted drawings.
- The extension will provide additional storage floorspace and will be constructed as a lightweight steel-framed structure, clad in light grey metal cladding.
- Formation of a new mezzanine level to the rear of the existing building, providing ancillary storage space. The mezzanine is fully contained within the existing building envelope and does not result in any external increase in height or massing.
- Installation of a new canopy over the customer entrance. The canopy spans in line with the projecting frontage of the main building and, in plan, serves to square off and unify the principal elevation. It is conceived as a lightweight architectural element that provides weather protection and visual emphasis to the entrance without increasing enclosed floorspace or altering the overall scale and massing of the building.
- Internal reconfiguration of the existing building to provide wholesale sales space, storage, offices, staff facilities, prayer room, kitchen and WC accommodation. Proposed new internal walls are shown in blue on the submitted plans, with existing walls retained and shown in grey.
- Re-cladding of the principal (front) elevation of the main building using a high-quality mix of black metal cladding and curtain glazing. Importantly, the re-cladding follows the same outline, scale and massing as the existing elevation, with no increase in height or footprint.
