It is out of character with the surrounding green belt area and if a building is required then it should be placed nearer the entrance. Or has it been devised like this to keep away from nearby houses? Furthermore I have lived & walked this land since the owner had his cows in adjoining fields & owned the original farm across Leymoor Road. The entrance he has repaired has been abandoned for many years but was originally used by them and although it led into the 1st field I have never seen the entrance used for vehicle access following on into the area for development. Any vehicle would have been driven over grass, definitely not a designated track.
