<p>My objections towards planning application number 2026/90452 are based over different aspects.</p> <p>Although the proposed plans for the house look very nice, I do feel that it is not in keeping with the other buildings around the area and would certainly not blend in. The traffic on Spring Grove adjacent to the bottom of Lower Common Lane is ridiculous, with traffic parking on both sides of the road making visibility from exiting Lower Common Lane extremely dangerous. Needless to say more cars would be added with such a large house planned. On top of this, there are the entrance gates to the local nursery across the road from the proposed driveway of the new build. School children cross the bottom of Lower Common Lane during the school week, both going to and coming home from school, and as we know full well, they do not take care when crossing roads. Spring Grove where our house is located has more than enough traffic passing through and parked up, and even has many heavy goods vehicles coming and going throughout the day, delivering goods to Spring Grove Mills, which I also believe should not be coming on this road, over the Victorian bridge where it is narrow and room for only one vehicle and is dangerous for anyone walking in that area. My next concern is the wildlife that could be nesting/living in the field, it's a perfect place for hedgehogs etc. On an evening, we have bats that come into our garden to feed and I feel sure that these come from the area of the land in question given that it is ideal for wildlife.</p> <p>Whilst I appreciate that the club want to make a better place for the community to enjoy, and need the money from this development to do so, I think more consideration should be made for the people living around the area as the parking for the club should be at the forefront when making a decision. When they hold events such as the bonfire night gathering, cars have no where to park but on Spring Grove and up Lower Common Lane. The people park stupidly on both sides of the road and block driveways making it extremely difficult for buses to get through let alone if a fire engine needed to pass through.
