<p>The access site for this development is in a dangerous location close to the junction with Barnsley Road. Excessive traffic in this area &amp; high density of pedestrian use cannot safely accommodate a new vehicular access point. Access should be safe and not adversely affect the amenity of neighbours. There is already an access point each side of the proposed access creating another will cause all three to diverge on to Lower Common Lane near the junction. Directly across is the day nursery which brings in a heavy amount of traffic and a lane serving properties on Spring Grove. These historic accesses were created when road traffic was negligible but now this is one of the busiest locations around the village. Barnsley Road is already made into single file traffic because of excessive parking especially from non residents and it is a frequent bus route &amp; road for heavy goods vehicles to the mill on Spring Grove. This causes queueing traffic around the proposed access site. The development requires a safe effective access and this site does NOT provide this.</p> <p>It is 3.66m wide &amp; 45m long bordered on one side by a mature hedge, trees and a stone wall and a fence on the other creating a corridor with poor visibility. See fig. 2 in Preliminary Ecological Appraisal . It also provides a wildlife connection between rural &amp; urban settings. Under current works proposals this habitat will be impacted.</p> <p>That is my strong OBJECTION to this development proposal</p>
