The BT Street Hub would create an obstruction to the safe and free flow of pedestrian movements along the footway making it narrower and making it more difficult for pedestrians, wheelchair users, those with pushchairs and other vulnerable users, having a detrimental effect on their user experience.</p> <p>Pedestrian footfall is anticipated to increase on Ramsden Street due to significant regeneration schemes including Our Cultural Heart, along with public transport investment such as the refurbishment of Huddersfield Bus Station and the Transpennine Route Upgrade at the Huddersfield Railway Station. Ramsden Street will be a key pedestrian route between these locations.</p> <p>Any future improvement schemes to the footway would be affected by the BT Street Hub's power connections.</p>

The BT Street Hub would create unnecessary street clutter and a new obstacle on the footway. It could create a distraction for drivers near a pedestrian crossing point. Anticipated to be an even greater distraction outside of daylight hours when the screen will appear brighter. It may also create an obstacle for people getting into or out of a vehicle in the parking bay. Any future improvement schemes to the footway would be affected by the BT Street Hub's power connections.</p>
