The advertisements, images or messages displayed on the digital panel shall not change more than once every 10 seconds.

Reason: In the interest of amenity and public safety, to comply with the aims and objectives of LP21, LP24 and LP25 of the Kirklees Local Plan and Chapter 12 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

The intensity of the luminance of the advertisement display shall be controlled by the installation of a light sensor to adjust the illuminance levels to ambient light conditions.

Reason: In the interest of amenity and public safety, to comply with the aims and objectives of LP21, LP24 and LP25 of the Kirklees Local Plan and Chapter 12 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

Notwithstanding the requirements of condition 7, the intensity of the luminance of the advertisement display shall not exceed 300cd/m² on any part of the illuminated area in hours of darkness.

Reason: In the interest of amenity and public safety, to

comply with the aims and objectives of LP21, LP24 and LP25 of the Kirklees Local Plan and Chapter 12 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

The digital panel hereby granted consent shall not display any moving images, animation, flashing scrolling or video and no visual effects shall accompany the transition between any successive advertisements, images or messages.
