Good morning John,

I wish to comment on the above four applications which relate to the town centre.

It was my understanding that the blueprint for the town centre intended to make the pedestrian areas a less cluttered and more pleasant area for visitors to the town centre.

Permitting the addition of extra digital advertising will have a cumulative impact detrimental to the council's stated aims. This would lower the amenity 'attractiveness' of the street-scene. This is in my view shouldn't be permitted. NPPF paragraph 141 - Advertisements should be subject to control only in the interests of amenity and public safety, taking account of cumulative impacts.

There are already quite a few large digital structures adding more will only reduce the attractiveness of the town centre further.
