<p>I strenuously object to this extension of 11 Holmcliffe Avenue Taylor Hill. I haven't received a council letter advising me of their planning application that has been submitted and I've only just been informed by the applicant himself. This extension I believe will be 4 meters big that's 4 meters extended out from the main house at the rear. That is a huge extension in a small area, I believe their garden is only 5 meters from house to the back fence resulting in which will take away all of my daylight, sunlight into my garden from the south, All of my daylight and sunlight to my conservatory, kitchen and rear bedroom. Number 11, the main house currently now was built 5 years ago and is 3 meters away from my property and this extension will affect my living life considerably. Having that extension and the house together 3 meters away will completely run the the whole length of my property from front garden to the rear garden, it will be like living in a prison having a huge building with high walls (that wasn't there 5 years ago) it will totally ruin my life. And I'm extremely concerned about the de-valuation of my property and selling impact this will have if I wanted to do so. The extension also has sky lights into the roof so now I can be totally looked into my rear garden, kitchen, rear bedroom and my conservatory. Not only will this extension kill all my natural light but they're a number of protected trees extremely close by and a protected well established Horse Chestnut Tree just meters from my garden and number 11, which is a huge tree that takes up a lot of my natural light during the summer at best of times, but combine the tree with this extension being so close will reduce me to darkness. I'm concerned the Horsechestnut tree would be damaged especially the roots system as they dig down for foundations and I'm extremely concerned that this will weaken the strength of the tree support in the ground which could fall on my house. I cannot extend to you the anxiety I'm suffering right now and the worry it's giving me and I ask you consider everything I've mentioned above and please not grant permission. I'd happily invite the planners to my house for you to witness this for yourself and I'll be more than happy to discuss this further in person or phone call. Thank you.</p>
