Hi There,

New information concerning the below comment I provide don 22nd April 2026 has been provided:

GCN – there is a pond onsite – which is to be lost to the development. An eDNA survey was conducted and returned a positive result, indicating that GCN could be using the site. Further surveys will need to be conducted prior to determination in order to assess the population onsite and ascertain if a licence is required.

The report regarding GCN (Futures Ecology, April 2026) confirms that the pond has below average suitability; and that eDNA testing returned as negative – meaning that there are no GCN using the pond.

Precautionary measures should be added to the CEMP to ensure minimal impact to foraging / commuting GCN.

All other comments made are unchanged.
